- ✓ the proposed indicator is **relevant to the most common goals** of relief and development interventions (no highly specialized or country-specific indicators)
- ✓ the indicator clearly **demonstrates the results and impact** of the interventions
- ✓ you **provide all the required information** – indicator's name, exact phrasing (as you do in logframes), purpose, clear guidance on how to collect the required data (please be sufficiently specific) and important comments people should consider
- ✓ the guidance you provide is **technically correct, feasible and easy to understand**
- ✓ the original source of any texts you use is clearly **acknowledged**
