Post Distribution Monitoring

This indicator can be built upon to gather feedback directly from teachers / education personnel regarding the adequacy of the materials provided. To do this, INEE Indicator 4.12 Percentage of teachers who report having adequate teaching and learning materials and teaching and preparation space can be used. Sample survey questions that can be used to ascertain this information could include:

Q1: Did you receive a teaching or [specify: school / learning space] kit?

A1: Yes / No / Don't know / Refuse to answer

(consider asking the following questions only if the previous answer is YES)

The following questions are not required to determine the indicator's value but can provide you with useful additional insights:

Q2: How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the quantity / quality of items within the distributed teaching or [specify: school / learning space] kit?

A2: Very satisfied / Satisfied / Neutral / Dissatisfied / Very dissatisfied / Don't know / Refuse to answer

Q3: Why were you dissatisfied with the materials you received?

Needs Assessment

This indicator can additionally be used as part of a Needs Assessment process to understand the degree to which teachers and education personnel have access to adequate teaching and learning materials. In this case, survey questions are designed to determine teachers' access to materials. For example:
