#### **Indicator Phrasing**

**English:** number of successfully piloted social protection innovations in the past [specify the number] months

#### What is its purpose?

The indicator measures the number of implemented social protection innovations (new services, approaches, etc.) which passed the pre-defined criteria of a "successful piloting".

## How to Collect and Analyse the Required Data

Calculate the indicator's value by using the following methodology:

- 1) Pre-define the criteria of a "successful piloting". This can include, for example:
- > the pilot was able to provide clear evidence of its benefits, especially when compared to the existing services or approaches
  - > the pilot can be scaled up in a cost-efficient way
- > scaling up the pilot does not face any major opposition from the main stakeholders in the given (sub)sector
  - > the pilot provided clear lessons learned and recommendations for its scale up
- 2) **Assess whether the pre-defined criteria were met** by reviewing relevant documentation and conducting interviews with the concerned personnel.
- 3) Calculate the number of implemented pilots which meet the pre-defined criteria.

# **Important Comments**

1) Proving the benefits of the given pilot might require you to conduct a **survey involving a control group**, enabling you to assess the actual benefits brought by the new service or approach.
