

### AVAILABILITY OF SOAP

Output indicator, Cluster indicator

## **Indicator Phrasing**

**English:** % of respondents which can within one minute bring and show a soap from their dwelling

**French:** % des répondants qui peuvent, en une minute, apporter et montrer un savon de leur habitation

Portuguese: % de inquiridos que conseguem dentro de um minuto trazer e mostrar sabão de sua casa

Czech: % respondentů, jež dokáže během jedné minuty přinést ze svých obydlí mýdlo na mytí rukou

### What is its purpose?

Washing hands with soap is the most effective way of preventing life-threatening diarrhoeal diseases. The indicator therefore assesses the proportion of households having soap available for their use.

## How to Collect and Analyse the Required Data

Collect the following data by conducting individual interviews with a <u>representative sample</u> of the adult members of your target households:

#### RECOMMENDED SURVEY QUESTIONS (Q) AND POSSIBLE ANSWERS (A)

**Q1**: Do you currently have any soap for washing hands?

A1: yes / no / doesn't know

(ask the following question only if the previous answer is YES)

**Q2**: Can you please show it to me?

**A2**:

- 1) soap was reported and is available
- 2) soap was reported and is available, but it took longer than 1 minute to bring
- 3) soap was reported but is NOT available

To **calculate the indicator's value**, divide the number of respondents who brought and showed soap within one minute, by the total number of respondents. Multiply the result by 100 to convert it to a percentage.

# Disaggregate by

Disaggregate the data by wealth.

## Important Comments

- 1) According to <u>UNHCR's standards</u>, the proportion of households having soap at home should be  $\geq$  90%.
- 2) **ECHO's list of the Key Result Indicators (KRI)** uses a different version of a soap-related indicator: "number of people having regular access to soap to meet hygienic needs". ECHO's guidance on the use of this indicator is available below.
- 3) **USAID/OFDA** uses a different version of this indicator: "number of households with soap and water at a hand washing location".
- 4) Do not count washing powder and other detergents as 'soap' as it is very unlikely that they would be used for washing hands daily.
